

ATTENTION

Beginning November 7, 2024, DOB rules will require that in order to operate a rotary telehandler:

If you hold an HMO Class A, B, or C license: You must ALSO possess an NCCCO Rotating Telehandler Operator certification.

If you DO NOT hold an HMO Class A, B, or C license: You must: (1) possess the required NCCCO certification; (2) have completed an 8-hour HMO refresher course; AND (3) have 1,500 hours of experience operating rotary telehandlers within the past 5 years.

NCCCO practical exams and study materials for the written exam are available at the Montrose Training Facility. Applications for the HMO Limited Rotating Telehandler license are expected to be made available by DOB in August. We will provide further information as we receive it.
